

# Big Bend Brewfest just around the corner

Get ready to test your beer palate and try flavors you've never tried before. The Big Bend Brewfest is coming to town Saturday, March 2, from 5-8 p.m. at Rosehead Park.

The Big Bend Brewfest is a Rotary Club of Perry event that offers unlimited tastings of different beers to raise funds to donate to the Perry Police Department's "Shop With a Cop" Program and to the Rotary Club Foundation, Rotary scholarships and other Rotary civic projects

throughout the county and the world.

"It's kind of like a wine-tasting," Chamber of Commerce Director Dawn Taylor said. "It's an opportunity to try new things and new flavors you may have never tried before."

Craft beer will be the focus of the festival, with many beer styles represented, including pale ales, IPAs, porters, stouts, wheats, ambers and lagers.

The festival will also include giveaways, live music and a deejay, along

with food vendors.

Standard admission tickets are \$25 and include: entry to the festival and unlimited beer tastings. Organizers anticipate the event being sold out and suggest that participants get their tickets in advance.

No person under 21 years old is allowed at the festival, including Designated Driver ticket holders. All persons must show valid ID at event entrance, which will be staffed by local law enforcement.
