Thomas Johnson, pre-trial, resisting officer with violence, battery on law enforcement officer, 4/9/17; Public Defender: new witness in this case, continued to 2/4/19.

Haywood Tullus Kinsey III, motion hearing, possession of methamphetamine, 3/10/18; Defendant stated he did not have a drug problem, DOC to file VOP per state attorney.

Jim Daniel Lundy, VOP arraignment, possession of methamphetamine, 8/25/18; credited 60 days, VOP denied, VOP pre-trial continued to 1/22/19.

Curtis Less Mango, pre-trial, sexual battery by one with familial authority, lewd or lascivious molestation of a child, 3/21/17; ready for trial.

Thomas Lee Mathis Jr, VOP arraignment, burglary of structure, 3/25/18; VOP admitted modified probation, 6 months inpatient rehab after defendant admitted drug problem.

Stacy Marie McClellan, VOP arraignment, possession of a controlled substance, felony driving with license suspended or revoked permanently, 4/27/17; contraband in a count detention facility, felony drive while license revoked, 6/29/17; VOP denied, VOP continued to 1/22/19.

arraignment, possession methamphetamine, 3/30/16; VOP admitted, adjudication withheld maintained, admitted drug problem, Community Center for 12 months.

Jonnetrich Price, sentencing, sexual battery, 11/15/8; probation revoked, 30 months Department of Correction, credited for 235 days served.
