Timeline details Warf's contact with law enforcement

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events documenting local law enforcement agencies' contact with Warf, family members and friends:

On June 11, 2019, Warf was reportedly transported from the local hospital to Tallahassee for observation under the Baker Act — a Florida law that enables families and loved ones to provide emergency mental health services and temporary detention for people who may be impaired due to mental illness and who may be unable to determine their need for treatment.

Just over one week later, at 2:49 a.m. on June 20, 2019, a complainant in Jacksonville called and alleged Warf was "making statements that could be construed as suicidal threats on social media," including: "To my family, I love you all no matter what

happens." TCSO deputies responded to a Dice Road residence and made contact with Warf, who they determined, "according to his own admission, had no intentions of harming himself."

One week later on June 26, 2019, at 8:46 p.m., a complainant called in reference to a white male "acting delusional and falling down" in the area of Walmart. PPD units responded and transported Warf to a residence at 2212 Dice Road.

On July 10, 2019, in response to a report of a possible theft at Walmart, Perry Police Department (PPD) officers reviewed video footage of Warf allegedly stealing Listerine.

On July 27, 2019 at 10:26 p.m., Warf's mother called to advise she had not seen her son in two weeks, according to a report taken by TCSO Sgt. Mike

O'Connor. According to his mother, Warf was incarcerated at the Taylor County Jail, and it was not unusual for her son to not make contact with her for extended periods of time due to "his addictions."

According to the report taken by Sgt. O'Connor, "Warf had spent a significant amount of time living in the wooded area behind Walmart, and earlier that day (July 27, 2019) she had went there to make contact with him and smelled a foul odor."

According to the timeline compiled by the TCSO, "Sgt. O'Connor acted on this information, and according to his report, did not make contact with Warf or detect any foul odor."

"Sgt. O'Connor also documented that according to Laura Warf, her son was not medication dependent, nor had made any statements that would

lead her to believe that he would hurt himself or others.

"He summed up his report by stating that Warf is an adult male, who by all accounts, is of sound mind and able to function normally without the help of others. He also stated that there was no information to suggest foul play," Cash's timeline concluded.

Warf's mother called the following day (July 28 at 1:39 p.m.) and requested to speak to an officer about what to do to find her son.

According to computer-aided dispatch (CAD) reports, a PPD officer spoke to Warf approximately one hour earlier and "stated that he seemed ok," noting Warf was living "off Calhoun Street."

A felony warrant for violation of probation was issued for Warf on Aug. 14, 2019.

According to the warrant, among other violations,

Warf failed to report on July 12 and Aug. 13, 2019.

"He also failed to procure consent to change his address from Dice Road as told to Officer Joe Rowe by a family member on July 20."

On Aug. 28, 2019, TCSO Dep. Lucas Hamilton responded to a complaint made by Warf's mother in reference to a missing person.

According to the report, Warf had been missing for about a month, and it was noted he had an active warrant for felony violation of probation (VOP).

Warf was entered into the national missing persons database on Aug. 28.

On Sept. 6, Cash was approached by Warf's brother in reference to him being missing and immediately passed this information onto investigators in TCSO's Criminal Investigation Division (CID).

TCSO Inv. Bryan Hayden spoke with Warf's brother on Sept. 6 and Sept. 9 at the Taylor County Jail, receiving information regarding Warf's mental state, medical condition, a "serious drinking problem" as well as the fact he was known to frequent various wooded areas in Perry.

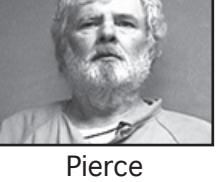
Acting on this information, on Sept. 9, TCSO Lt. Deeson and Inv. Hayden searched the areas behind the Star Food Mart in the wooded area behind Winn-Dixie, the old car wash near Byron Butler Parkway and the woods behind Walmart, "finding some old campsites, but no persons were present."

Hayden reportedly made multiple attempts to speak with Warf's father and an individual at Warf's last known physical address to speak to both individuals, but was unable to make contact.

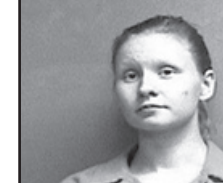
