

DEO certifies to HUD that Reginald Dixon, in his capacity as Director of DEO's Office of Disaster Recovery, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the federal courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows DEO to use the program funds.

#### **OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE** OF FUNDS

HUD will accept objections to its release of funds and DEO's certification for a period of 15 days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of DEO: (b) DEO has omitted a step or failed to make a decision of finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of the release of funds by HUD; or (d) another federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted via email in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58,76) and shall be addressed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in the Office of Community Planning and Development at kenneth.m.pinnix@hud.gov.
