The purpose of this project is to replace the D0 Stage Washer and associated dilution pump and hydro-doctor, repair or replace the existing tile vat and filtrate tank and modify the steam mixer in the No. 2 Purification Plant. This project is part of a previously issued Permit No. 1230001-078-AC. Pollutants affected by this project are carbon monoxide (CO), volatile organic compounds (VOC) and total reduced sulfur (TRS). Emissions increases from this project are minimal and combined for both projects are 24.95 tons per year (TPY) of CO; 12.03 TPY of VOC; and 6.18 TPY of TRS.
