Emission increases from the project consist of: 28.2 tons per year (TPY) of carbon monoxide (CO); 0.4 TPY of volatile organic compounds; and 0.1 TPY of total reduced sulfur. Therefore, the project did not trigger preconstruction review for the Prevention of Significant Deterioration of Air Quality. However, due to the emission increases of CO, actual emissions for CO shall be reported for 5-years after completion of the project. Note, emission reporting will begin in the first full calendar year after completion of the project. In addition, the permittee is required to keep records and report to the Department on the amount of pulp produced and the carbon dioxide application rate for a period of 5 years after completion of the project.
