
# Welcome Home.

# **Demps recognized for** perfect attendance by **Planning Council**

Taylor County Commissioner Thomas Demps was recently awarded the "James H. Montgomery Certificate of Outstanding Attendance" by Scott Koons, executive director of the North Central Florida Regional Planning Council.

The certificate was awarded in recognition of Commissioner Demps' attendance at every scheduled council meeting during 2021-22 program year.

He has served on the council since January 2017, representing Taylor County as a local elected official.

The council named its Member Attendance Recognition Program the "James H. Montgomery Certificate of Outstanding Attendance" in honor of Mr. Montgomery, who served on the council from 1976 to 2004, representing the Board of County Commissioners of Columbia County.

From 2010 to 2019, Montgomery served on the council as a gubernatorial appointee representing Columbia County. He served as chair of the council three times and provided 38 years of distinguished leadership and service.

The council's membership includes local elected officials and gubernatorial appointees. The council, in partnership with economic development organizations and local governments, promotes regional strategies, partnerships and solutions to strengthen the economic competitiveness and quality of life of 12 counties and 40 incorporated municipalities in north central Florida.

Demps currently serves as immediate past chair of the council and chair of the nominating committee. He has previously served as vice-chair of the council; secretary-treasurer of the council; chair of the finance committee; and chair of the program committee.

The Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") gives notice of agency action of entering into a Consent Order with Foley Cellulose LLC (Foley Mill) pursuant to

section 120.57 (4), Florida Statutes. The Consent Order addresses the unauthorized discharge of untreated or partially treated wastewater on February 19, 2021, May 7, 2021, September 26, 2021, and March 13, 2022, and effluent-limitation exceedances between April 30, 2018 and March 31, 2022. The Consent Order is available for public inspection during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, at the Department of Environmental Protection, 8800 Baymeadows Way W, suite 100, Jacksonville, Florida, 32256.

Persons who are not parties to this Consent Order, but whose substantial interests are affected by it, have a right to petition for an administrative hearing under sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes. Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition concerning this Consent Order means that the Department's final action may be different from the position it has taken in the Consent Order.

The petition for administrative hearing must contain all of the following information:

a) The OGC Number assigned to this Consent Order;

b) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner; the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding;

c) An explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the Consent Order; d) A statement of when and how

the petitioner received notice of the

Consent Order; e) Either a statement of all material facts disputed by the petitioner or a statement that the petitioner does

not dispute any material facts;

f) A statement of the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Consent Order;

g) A statement of the rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Consent Order; and

h) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the Department to take with respect to the Consent Order.

must be filed The petition (received) at the Department's Office of General Counsel, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, MS# 35, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000, or received via electronic correspondence at Agency\_Clerk@ floridadep.gov, within 21 days of receipt of this notice. A copy of the petition must also be mailed at the time of filing to the District Office at 8800 Baymeadows Way West, Suite 100, Jacksonville, Florida, 32256. Failure to file a petition within the 21-day period constitutes a person's waiver of the right to request an administrative hearing and to participate as a party to this proceeding under sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes. Before the deadline for filing a petition, a person whose substantial interests are affected by this Consent Order may choose to pursue mediation as an alternative remedy under section 120.573, Florida Statutes. Choosing mediation will not adversely affect such person's right to request an administrative hearing if mediation does not result in a settlement. Additional information about mediation is provided in section 120.573, Florida Statutes, and Rule 62-110.106(12), Florida Administrative Code.
