to the store, which is located in Perry Plaza (formerly home to Andrews Drug Store), around midnight Saturday in response to an alarm.

"When they arrived, they observed the front (glass) door had been busted out. After entering, they cleared the building of any intruders and saw that several glass display cases had been broken into. PPD K9 John Arnold and his K9 partner started tracking the suspects. The track was subsequently turned over to K9 teams from Taylor Correctional Institution (TCI) and Cross City Correctional Institution. We are currently working leads based on the results of the K9 track," PPD Capt. Lin Gray said.
